



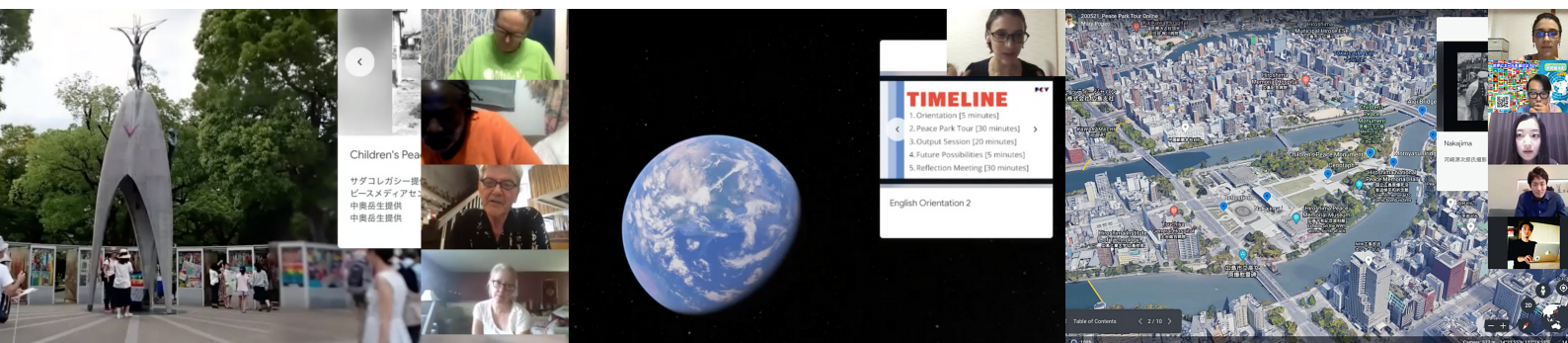
EXPERIENCE HIROSHIMA, ONLINE
